## IMPORTANT NOTICE FOR AQUARIUS UTILITIES CUSTOMERS

June 24, 2022

Dear Customers,

In June 2022, a subsidiary of NW Natural Water Company, LLC ("NW Natural Water"), Cascadia Water, LLC ("Cascadia Water"), filed an application with the Washington Utilities and Transportation Commission ("UTC") to acquire the assets of Aquarius Utilities, L.L.C. ("Aquarius Utilities"). This transfer is contingent upon approval by the UTC.

Cascadia is an investor-owned water company and is a public service company subject to the UTC jurisdiction. Cascadia serves approximately 2,400 customers on three water systems on the Olympic Peninsula in both Clallam and Jefferson Counties, and 12 water systems located on Whidbey Island in Island County.

After the sale is approved, the Aquarius Utilities system will continue to be operated locally by current personnel and Cascadia Water expects that the transition will be seamless to customers. Aquarius Utilities' current rates and charges will not change as a result of this transaction and Cascadia Water will be required to notify all affected customers of any future rate increases.

UTC staff will make a recommendation to the Commissioners at an open meeting which is scheduled for 9:30am on July 28, 2022. The UTC building is closed to the public until further notice. This open meeting will be conducted remotely. If you intend to listen or participate, call 360-664-1234 at least a day before the open meeting for instructions and to sign in.
