I joined PSE in 1999 as an Associate General Counsel. I also served as PSE's Director of Load Resource Strategies. In February of 2003, I became Vice President of Regulatory and Government Affairs, in which position I was responsible for PSE's regulatory strategy at this Commission and at the Federal Energy Regulatory Commission, and for governmental affairs at the federal level. In May of 2003, I became Executive Vice President and Chief Resource Officer. I was named president of PSE in June 2010 and CEO in March 2011.
