NOTICE TEMPORARILY POSTPONING PROCEEDING

RE: Relating to the Commission's proceeding to develop a policy statement addressing alternatives to traditional cost of service rate making, Docket U-210590

TO ALL INTERESTED PERSONS:

The State Legislature directed the Commission, in Section 1 of Engrossed Substitute Senate Bill 5295, to conduct a proceeding to develop a policy statement addressing alternatives to traditional cost of service ratemaking, including performance-based measures or goals, targets, performance incentives, and penalty mechanisms.

Responding to the legislation, the Commission developed a work plan, sought participant feedback before reporting to the Legislature, and began Phase 1, Performance Metrics. In Phase 1, the Commission engaged in extensive public participation and incorporated comments from that engagement to define regulatory goals, desired outcomes, design principles, and identify related metrics. At the conclusion of Phase 1, the Commission will be issuing a policy statement that will provide guidance on defining regulatory goals, desired outcomes, design principles, and metrics.

The Commission continues to anticipate conducting this proceeding in multiple phases over several years. The next phase in the proceeding is Phase 2A, in which the Commission intends to provide guidance on selected metric calculations, reporting, and review process.

NOTICE TEMPORARILY POSTPONING PROCEEDING

The Commission is temporarily postponing its activities in this Docket through April 2023 given the press of business before the Commission, and the resources necessary to consider issues and fiscal impacts from proposals in the current legislative session. Commission staff and participants in this proceeding are likely actively engaged in the legislative process and would benefit from

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additional time and resources to support the efforts in the proceeding.

Participants are encouraged to continue to provide comments in response to the January 5, 2023, of Opportunity to File Written Comments on the Phase 2A work plan. Your feedback will be used Notice to inform the Phase 2A work plan.

In early May 2023, the Commission will resume its work on the Phase 1 policy statement. The Commission will also update both the Phase 2A work plan timeline and the timeline for the remaining phases.
