## Re: Avista Corporation, d/b/a Avista Utilities's 2021 Clean Energy Implementation Plan **Docket UE-210628**

## TO ALL INTERESTED PERSONS:

The Washington Utilities and Transportation Commission (Commission) will review Avista Corporation's d/b/a Avista Utilities's (Avista or Company) 2021 clean energy implementation plan (CEIP or Plan) at an open public meeting. The Commission will enter an order approving, rejecting, or approving with conditions Avista's CEIP at the conclusion of its review.<sup>1</sup> Per <u>WAC</u> <u>480-100-640</u>(1), a CEIP describes the utility's plan for making progress toward meeting the clean energy transformation standards, and is informed by the utility's integrated resource plan and clean energy action plan. The CEIP requirements are specified in <u>RCW 19.405.060</u>(1).

Avista representatives will present the Plan to the Commission and respond to questions from the Commissioners and the public at a recessed open meeting of the Commission to be held on **Thursday, June 16, 2022, at 1:00 p.m.** Due to the ongoing COVID-19 public health crisis, the Commission will be holding the meeting virtually. Commission headquarters will not be open to the public for in-person participation.
