Dear Mr. Danner,

Condition No. 22 in the Docket UT-100820 merger settlement agreement between CenturyLink, Commission Staff and Public Counsel, adopted by the Commission in its Order 14 in the docket, requires the filing with the Commission of semi-annual reports concerning the integration of retail operational support systems:

22. OSS - Retail

CenturyLink agrees to submit to Commission Staff and Public Counsel semiannual integration status reports following the close of the Transaction. The initial report will be submitted within 90 days after the Transaction closes and will continue semi-annually for four years (reports will be provided within 30 days following the end of each semi-annual period). At a minimum, the reports will include a summary of integration-related activity completed since the last filed report and key milestones, deliverables and implementation timelines, and major risks and contingency plans for the upcoming quarter and beyond, if available, for all substantial integration team efforts.
