On January 3, 2001, the Commission directed the Secretary to file a Notice of Proposed Rulemaking (CR-102) with the office of the Code Reviser in Docket U-991301, to move the rule relating to Price Lists from Chapter 480-120 Telecommunications Operations to Chapter 480-80 Commission General – Tariffs.
