NOTICE SUSPENDING PROCEDURAL SCHEDULE

and

NOTICE REQUIRING FILING OF SETTLEMENT DOCUMENTS (By September 20, 2019)

RE: Washington Utilities and Transportation Commission v. Cascade Natural Gas Corporation, Docket UG-190210

TO ALL PARTIES:

On March 29, 2019, Cascade Natural Gas Corporation (Cascade or Company) filed with the Washington Utilities and Transportation Commission (Commission) revisions to its currently effective Tariff WN U-3.

On April 18, 2019, the Commission entered Order 03, Prehearing Conference Order; Notice of Hearing (Order 03), which established a procedural schedule including, among other things, an evidentiary hearing set for November 4-5, 2019.

On August 23, 2019, Commission staff (Staff) sent an email to the administrative law judge to inform the Commission that the parties have reached a full settlement in principle, and requested that the procedural schedule be suspended while the parties finalize their settlement agreement.

The Commission finds good cause to grant the request and suspend the filing deadlines established by the procedural schedule. The dates for the public comment hearing and the evidentiary hearing will remain unchanged. The parties are required to file the settlement agreement and supporting testimony, or a status report of the parties' progress, no later than 5 p.m., September 20, 2019.
