Re: DISTRIBUTION UPGRADES RELATED TO TACOMA LNG PROJECT

In his prefiled direct testimony (Exh. DAH-1T at 7:1-12 and 8:3-7), Mr. Henderson describes the gas distribution upgrades required to connect the Tacoma LNG project with PSE's gas distribution system. The following amounts have been included in PSE's test year capital:

Upgrade 1: Four miles of new piping connecting the Tacoma LNG Project to the PSE natural gas distribution system = \$27.4 million (final cost)

Upgrade 2: One mile of 12-inch high pressure piping installed along Golden Given Road East, and installation of the new Golden Given Limit Station = \$0.00 (postponed pending in-service date for the Tacoma LNG Project)

Upgrade 3: Upgrades to the Frederickson Gate Station = \$4.1 million
