NOTICE OF OPPORTUNITY TO WAIVE RIGHT TO INITIAL ORDER (Waivers due by Tuesday, June 9, 2009, at 12:00 p.m.)

TO ALL PARTIES:

On May 28, 2009, Points Recycling and Refuse, LLC (Points), filed a request with the Washington Utilities and Transportation Commission (Commission) asking that the Commission revoke his solid waste certificate, G-155, effective June 30, 2009. Points also asserted that it would not be participating further in any of these dockets.

Pursuant to RCW 81.77 and WAC 480-70-081 *et seq.*, the Commission has authority to grant and cancel the certificated authority of solid waste haulers within the state of Washington. Given that Points has voluntarily requested cancellation of its certificate, effective less than one month from the issuance of this notice, a speedy resolution of Points' request to surrender its certificate is appropriate. If the parties would like the Commission to address the matter in a final, rather than initial order, the Commission requests the parties submit letters waiving their right to an initial order, pursuant to WAC 480-07-820(1)(b)(iv). Absent a waiver from all of the parties, the presiding judge would enter an initial order which would then not become final for 20 days if no petition for administrative review is received. Should the Commission receive waivers from all of the parties, the Commission could enter a final order before June 30.

NOTICE IS GIVEN That the parties may submit waivers of the right to an initial order addressing Points Recycling and Refuse, LLC's voluntary request for cancellation of its solid waste certificate in this matter. Parties must file an original and four (4) paper copies of their waiver with the Commission by Tuesday, June 9, 2009, at 12:00 p.m.
