PUBLIC COUNSEL RESPONSE TO CLEC INTERVENORS' JOINT MOTION TO DISMISS

Pursuant to Order February 15, 2013 (Prehearing Conference Order 02) in this docket,
Public Counsel files this response to the CLEC Intervenors' Joint Motion to Dismiss. While
Public Counsel does not take a position with respect to the wholesale issues raised by the
CLECs, Public Counsel shares the concerns raised regarding the statutory vehicle chosen by
Frontier for this filing. It appears that Frontier's filing should more properly have been made
under the statute permitting competitive classification of services, RCW 80.36.330, rather than
under RCW 80.36.320. Even as filed, Frontier's petition seeks only partial relief from its
regulatory obligations, as it "does not impact Frontier's obligations with respect to: participation
in low-income and hearing impaired programs; public safety, including E-911; Eligible
Telecommunications Carrier status; carrier of last resort; or Section 251 and 252 interconnection
and wholesale obligations under the Telecommunications Act." Since the filing, initial
discovery by Staff and Public Counsel indicates that the level of competition faced by Frontier
varies significantly between services and geographic areas. Accordingly, Public Counsel

supports the recommendation of the CLEC Intervenors in their motion,² that should the Commission decline to dismiss the Petition altogether, that "the Commission deem the Petition to be a request for competitive classification of Frontier's retail services pursuant to RCW 80.36.330.
