ICNU is an incorporated, non-profit association of large industrial electric customers in the Pacific Northwest. A list of ICNU members is included as Attachment A. Certain members of ICNU purchase power services from Puget Sound Energy ("PSE" or the "Company"), as indicated on Attachment A. ICNU has been a party to many proceedings before the Commission involving PSE, including the Company's most recent general rate and power cost rate cases.

ICNU's member companies have a substantial interest in PSE's proposed adjustment to its power cost rate, which PSE filed as revisions to Tariff WN U-60 on April 25, 2013. The Company's filing would decrease charges and rates for electric service by approximately \$616,833, or 0.03 percent. The Company's proposed rate change would substantially and directly affect those of ICNU's members who purchase power from PSE. ICNU requests leave to intervene in this proceeding to represent its members who would be affected by the proposed rate decrease.

ICNU has extensive experience involving PSE's rates. ICNU's intervention in this proceeding will assist the Commission in resolving the issues and will not unreasonably broaden the issues, burden the record, or delay this proceeding.
