MOTION FOR FURTHER EXTENSION OF TIME

1. Verizon Northwest Inc. ("Verizon") respectfully moves for a further extension of time for the parties to submit the completed issues list required by the Commission's Order No. 6 of June 18, 2004. Verizon represents that it is authorized to state that Competitive Carrier Coalition, the Competitive Carrier Group, MCI and AT&T have consented to this Motion. In support of this Motion, Verizon respectfully states as follows:

2. On June 16, 2004, the D.C. Circuit's mandate issued in *United States Telecom Association v. FCC*, 359 F.3d 554 (D.C. Cir. 2004). With the issuance of the D.C. Circuit's

mandate, Verizon will be able to simplify substantially its proposed *Triennial Review Order* amendment. Verizon anticipates filing a shorter, revised amendment with the Commission within the next few weeks. Verizon anticipates that the arbitration could then proceed on the basis of that shorter, revised amendment, reducing the burden on the parties and on the Commission.

3. Counsel for Verizon accordingly has conferred with Philip Macres, counsel for the Competitive Carrier Coalition; Letty Friesen, counsel for AT&T; Michel Singer-Nelson, counsel for MCI; and Heather Hendrickson, counsel for Competitive Carrier Group. These CLEC parties do not oppose Verizon's request for additional time, with the clarification that CLECs will desire additional time for negotiation, development of an issues list, and submission of briefs after the filing of the revised amendment. Once Verizon files the revised amendment, Verizon will confer with the CLECs and submit a further motion asking the Commission to establish a date certain for filing an issues list or other appropriate filing(s).

4. Verizon has also conferred with other parties. XO Time Warner Telecom and Sprint may oppose this motion.

WHEREFORE, Verizon respectfully moves for an extension of time for the parties to

submit the completed issues list required by the Commission's Order No. 6 until an appropriate time after submission of Verizon's revised proposed amendment.
