By application filed with the Washington Utilities and Transportation Commission June 2, 2003, Peninsula Sanitation Service, Inc., requested extension of authority under Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity No. G-11 to operate motor vehicles in:

SOLID WASTE COLLECTION SERVICE In that portion of Pacific County described as follows: starting at the northwest corner of Section 16, T15N, R10W; thence south along the west line of said section extended to the south township line of T14N, R10W (generally in the vicinity of Section 33); thence east along south line of said township extended to the southeast corner of Section 36, T14N, R10W; thence north along the east line of said section extended to the northeast corner of Section 13, T15N, R10W; thence west along the north line of said section extended to the northwest corner of Section 16, T15N, R10W, the point of beginning.

2 Upon consideration of all the evidence of record, the Commission finds that the applicant is fit, willing and able to properly conduct the proposed operations and that the service sought to be rendered is necessary and will be a convenience to the public.

## **ORDER**

WHEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED That the application herein be and the same is hereby granted and contingent upon the applicant having complied with the provisions of RCW 81.77 and the rules relating to solid waste companies. Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity No. G-11 shall be amended, as per the attached Appendix A.

The Commission further orders that the tariff filed in connection with this application will become effective at 12:01 a.m. on the day following the service date of this order.

## APPENDIX A

SOLID WASTE COLLECTION SERVICE in Pacific County excluding the territory around the Tokeland Peninsula described as follows: Starting at the northeast corner of Section 17, T15N, R10W; thence south on the east line of said section extended to the southeast corner of Section 32, T14N, R10W; thence west on the south line of said section projected to its intersection with the western boundary of Washington State; thence north along said boundary to its intersection with the westerly projection of the north line of Section 17, T15N, R10W (a point in the Pacific Ocean); thence east on said projection to the northeast corner of Section 17, T15N, R10W, the point of beginning.

SOLID WASTE COLLECTION SERVICE in that portion of Wahkiakum County described as follows: Starting at the point where the north-south center line of Section 12, T9N, R7W intersects with the north shore line of the Columbia River; thence north on said line projected to the Pacific-Wahkiakum County Line; thence west and south on said county line to the north bank of the Columbia River; thence easterly along the north bank of the Columbia River to the center line of Section 12, T9N, R7W, the point of beginning.
