**NOTICE OF EXTENSION OF TIME TO FILE ANSWER
TO FORMAL COMPLAINT
(By December 15, 2004)**

TO ALL PARTIES:

On November 17, 2004, a formal complaint was filed with the Commission by Sandy Judd and Tara Herivel, complainants, against AT&T Communications of the Pacific Northwest, Inc. (AT&T) and T-Netix, Inc. The complaint alleges that the respondents failed to disclose rates to the recipients of inmate-initiated collect calls.

On November 29, 2004, AT&T filed a Motion For Extension of Time to Respond or Otherwise Answer Complaint. AT&T states the Commission served the complaint to a staff person that is no longer with the company. AT&T also states that it notified the Commission in October of 2004, that the Staff person was no longer with the company and provided other names for purposes of service. AT&T states it did not receive the Complaint until November 23, 2004 and requests an extension of time to December 15, 2004, for filing its answer. The Commission finds good cause to grant the request.

NOTICE IS GIVEN That answers to the Formal Complaint must be filed no later than 5:00 p.m., December 15, 2004.
