NOTICE SUSPENDING PROCEDURAL SCHEDULE AND ESTABLISHING DATE FOR FILING SETTLEMENT DOCUMENTS

TO ALL PARTIES:

On December 30, 2009, the Washington Utilities and Transportation Commission (Commission) entered a Notice of Brief Adjudication in this matter. The Notice set Thursday, January 21, 2010, as the deadline for the parties to submit documentary evidence and set Thursday, January 28, 2010, as the time for the parties to make oral statements supporting their positions in the case.

On Friday, January 15, 2010, Commission Staff advised that it had reached a full settlement in principle with ITS Global. In order to provide sufficient time for the parties to reduce their accord to writing, Staff asked that the hearing scheduled for January 28, 2010, be canceled pending the filing of a Settlement Agreement and supporting Narrative.

The parties' request to suspend the procedural schedule is granted. The request complies with the requirements in WAC 480-07-385 for such requests, and will not prejudice the Commission or, as evidenced by their agreed request, the parties in this matter.

THE COMMISSION GIVES NOTICE That it suspends the current procedural schedule in this docket. The Brief Adjudicative Proceeding set for Thursday, January 28, 2010 at 1:30 p.m. shall be stricken.
