7	JUDGE WATSON: Let's go on the record.
8	My name is Stephany Watson, I am the
9	administrative law judge in this proceeding before the
10	Washington Utilities and Transportation Commission.
11	The docket number at issue is No. TV-121722, and it is
12	a complaint for cancellation of permit or failure to
13	pay regulatory fees and failure to file annual
14	reports.
15	Counsel for the State has asked for a short
16	break to confer with its witness. We will go back on
17	the record in 10 or 15 minutes.
18	MS. CAMERON-RULKOWSKI: Perfect, Your
19	Honor. Thank you.
20	JUDGE WATSON: Okay.
21	(A brief recess.)
22	JUDGE WATSON: We are back on the record
23	in Docket No. TV-121722 by the Washington Utilities
24	and Transportation Commission against respondents,
25	there are seven of them in this case 3rd Generation

- 1 Movers and Hauling, A+ Always Moving, Inc., A A Star
- 2 Transfer Company, Inc., Always Able Moving Service,
- 3 LLC, ARAYS Moving Service, LLC, d/b/a A-Rays Moving
- 4 Solutions, Grayport Transfer & Storage Co., Inc., and
- 5 Thunder Movers, LLC.
- 6 This is a case in which the Commission is
- 7 seeking cancellation of the permits of these seven
- 8 household goods carriers that have failed to pay
- 9 regulatory fees as required by RCW 80.80.321, and
- 10 failed to file annual reports as required by RCW
- 11 80.04.080.
- 12 Now, I may be mistaken again, and I'm sure
- 13 counsel will point this out, but my understanding is
- 14 that in this case, the Commission is also seeking
- 15 penalties against the companies of \$100 a day for each
- business day after May 1, 2012, that the report was
- 17 not filed, the fees were not paid, and an additional
- 18 fee of \$25 per day of each violation for the last five
- 19 years. That's what I have.
- 20 The parties are present. Will their attorneys
- 21 please introduce themselves?
- 22 First of all let me see, is anyone on the
- 23 bridge line, on the phone?
- 24 Thank you. Go ahead, Ms. Cameron-Rulkowski.
- MS. CAMERON-RULKOWSKI: Thank you, Your

- 1 Honor.
- 2 Appearing on behalf of Commission Staff,
- 3 Jennifer Cameron-Rulkowski, Assistant Attorney
- 4 General. My address is 1400 South Evergreen Park
- 5 Drive Southwest, Olympia, Washington 98504-7250. My
- 6 telephone number is (360) 664-1186. My fax number is
- 7 (360) 586-5522. My e-mail address is
- 8 jcameron@utc.wa.gov.
- 9 Your Honor, I did have a couple of preliminary
- 10 motions, if you would like me to begin with those.
- JUDGE WATSON: Sure. Thanks.
- 12 MS. CAMERON-RULKOWSKI: First off, Staff
- 13 moves to dismiss Thunder Movers, LLC, from this
- 14 proceeding because the Commission already had
- 15 cancelled the company's permit in another docket
- 16 before the complaint issued in the instant proceeding.
- 17 In Docket TV-121626, Thunder Mover's permit was
- 18 suspended, effective October 9, 2012, for 30 days, for
- 19 failure to file acceptable proof of insurance with the
- 20 Commission. The Commission subsequently cancelled
- 21 Thunder Mover's permit on or about November 16th,
- 22 2012. I do have a copy here of the cancellation order
- that is on file in Docket TV-121626. I am asking the
- 24 Commission to take official notice of this order.
- I am referring now to what has been marked as

- 1 Exhibit No. 1. Pursuant to WAC 480-07-495, the
- 2 Commission may take official notice of rules,
- 3 regulations, administrative rulings and orders
- 4 exclusive of findings of fact of the Commission and
- 5 other governmental agencies.
- 6 Staff offers this copy of the Thunder Mover's
- 7 cancellation order from Docket TV-121626 for admission
- 8 into evidence as Exhibit 1.
- 9 JUDGE WATSON: This exhibit will be
- 10 admitted and the motion granted. I don't see any
- 11 reason to delay this particular one.
- 12 MS. CAMERON-RULKOWSKI: Thank you, Your
- 13 Honor.
- Now, since the complaint in this proceeding
- was issued, some of the respondent companies have
- 16 filed annual reports and paid regulatory fees. For
- 17 each of these companies I plan to present evidence of
- 18 the company's compliance through Mr. Perkinson, seated
- 19 to my right. After the evidence has been presented,
- 20 Staff intends to move for dismissal of the complaint
- 21 with respect to some of these companies. With regard
- 22 to the remaining companies, Staff asks the Commission
- 23 to find each of them in default.
- 24 The companies that Staff is asking the
- 25 Commission to find in default are 3rd Generation

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1 Movers and Hauling, A A Star Transfer Co., Inc.,
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- 2 Always Able Moving Service, LLC, Grayport Transfer &
- 3 Storage.
- 4 Each of these companies was served by the
- 5 Commission by mail, and the proof of service is on
- 6 file in the records center under this docket. We have
- 7 a copy of that here, and that's marked as Exhibit 2.
- 8 From this proof of service, you can see that the
- 9 respondents were served by first class mail and by
- 10 registered mail with return receipt requested at the
- 11 addresses on file with the Commission.
- 12 Under WAC 480-15-065, a household goods
- 13 carrier is required to immediately notify the
- 14 Commission in writing if its mailing address changes.
- 15 The service was valid under the Commission's service
- 16 rule, WAC 480-07-150, which authorizes the Commission
- 17 in Subsection 7 to serve its notices, complaints and
- 18 orders by mail, properly addressed, with first class
- 19 postage prepaid. Some of the mailings were returned,
- or at least one of them was returned. I do have a
- 21 question or two for Mr. Perkinson about that once he
- 22 is sworn in.
- 23 At this time, Staff offers Exhibit 2 for
- 24 admission into evidence.
- 25 JUDGE WATSON: Exhibit 2 will be

1	admitted.
2	MS. CAMERON-RULKOWSKI: Staff asks that
3	the Commission find the respondents that I listed
4	earlier, in default under RCW 34.05.440 and WAC
5	480-07-450, for failure to appear at this hearing.
6	Staff further requests under these authorities that
7	the Commission proceed with the hearing and dispose of
8	the substantive issues.
9	JUDGE WATSON: We will do so, thank you.
10	3rd Generation Movers and Hauling, A A Star,
11	Always Able, Grayport?
12	MS. CAMERON-RULKOWSKI: That's correct,
13	Your Honor.
14	JUDGE WATSON: Okay.
15	MS. CAMERON-RULKOWSKI: At this time I
16	would like to call Mr. Perkinson.
17	JUDGE WATSON: Mr. Perkinson, please
18	raise your right hand.
19	
20	MATHEW PERKINSON, witness herein, having been
21	first duly sworn on oath,
22	was examined and testified
23	as follows:
24	JUDGE WATSON: Thank you.

- 1 DIRECT EXAMINATION
- 2 BY MS. CAMERON-RULKOWSKI:
- 3 Q Good afternoon, Mr. Perkinson.
- 4 A Hello.
- 5 Q Please state and your spell your name.
- 6 A Mathew Perkinson, M-A-T-H-E-W,
- 7 P-E-R-K-I-N-S-O-N.
- 8 Q Please state the name of your employer.
- 9 A The Washington Utilities and Transportation
- 10 Commission.
- 11 Q In what position are you employed by the
- 12 Commission?
- 13 A I am a compliance investigator.
- 14 Q How long have you been employed in this
- 15 position?
- 16 A For eight months.
- 17 Q How long have you been employed by the
- 18 Commission?
- 19 A 20 months.
- 20 Q Please briefly describe your responsibilities
- 21 as they pertain to this matter.
- 22 A Okay. I conduct investigations regarding the
- 23 business practices of regulated utility and
- 24 transportation companies. As part of my duties, I
- 25 investigate companies that are delinquent in filing

- 1 annual reports and paying regulatory fees.
- 2 Q What statute or rule do you understand to be
- 3 at issue in this proceeding today?
- 4 A RCW 81.04.080, which requires each household
- 5 goods carrier to file an annual report with the
- 6 Commission, RCW 81.80.321, which requires each
- 7 household goods carrier to pay an annual regulatory
- 8 fee, and WAC 480-15-480, which requires household
- 9 goods carriers to submit annual reports and regulatory
- 10 fees to the Commission no later than May 1st.
- 11 Q Are you familiar with the companies that are
- 12 named in this proceeding?
- 13 A Yes.
- 14 Q I will be asking you some questions later
- 15 about each individual company, but can you describe
- 16 generally how you are familiar with the respondent
- 17 companies?
- 18 A After May 1st, the financial services section
- 19 provides me with a list of all the companies that are
- 20 delinquent in filing an annual report and for paying
- 21 regulatory fees. The list is generated in the
- 22 Commission's Annual Report Tracking System, or ARTS
- 23 database. Financial services staff enters receipt
- 24 information for annual reports and regulatory fees and
- 25 a record is created for each company. Using the

- 1 companies on that list, I send out a notice of
- 2 enforcement, which tells the companies that their
- 3 penalty would be reduced from \$100 per day to \$25 per
- 4 day if they file their annual report and pay
- 5 regulatory fees no later than May 25th.
- 6 Two months after that, I issue penalty
- 7 assessments for companies who are late in filing or
- 8 had still not filed annual reports or paid regulatory
- 9 fees. And then three months after that, financial
- 10 services provides me with a list of companies that
- 11 still had not filed annual reports or paid regulatory
- 12 fees, which is also generated in the Commission's ARTS
- 13 database.
- 14 Finally, in this process, I recommend, based
- on my investigation, the companies' permits be
- 16 cancelled for failure to file annual reports or pay
- 17 regulatory fees.
- 18 Q Now, I have a couple of questions about
- 19 service for you. According to the proof of service in
- 20 this docket, the complaint was served by first class
- 21 mail and also was sent by certified mail. Were any of
- the certified mailings returned?
- 23 A Yes, Always Able Moving and Hauling, LLC, was
- 24 returned unclaimed, unable to forward.
- Q Were any of the first class mailings returned?

- 1 A No.
- 2 Q Have any of the respondent companies filed an
- 3 annual report or paid regulatory fees since the
- 4 complaint issued?
- 5 A Yes.
- 6 Q How did you determine that these companies had
- 7 come into compliance?
- 8 A I checked the Commission's ARTS database.
- 9 Q And when was the last time you checked ARTS?
- 10 A Today. This morning.
- 11 Q I will be asking you about the individual
- 12 companies now, in the order in which they are listed
- in the complaint.
- 14 Was 3rd Generation Movers and Hauling one of
- 15 the companies referred to you by financial services?
- 16 A Yes.
- 17 Q Has 3rd Generation Movers and Hauling filed a
- 18 2011 annual report or paid the 2012 regulatory fee?
- 19 A No.
- 20 Q What is your recommendation to the Commission
- 21 regarding this company?
- 22 A I recommend that the Commission cancel the
- 23 company's permit.
- Q Was A+ Always Moving, Inc., one of the
- companies referred to you by financial services?

- 1 A Yes.
- Q Has A+ Always Moving, Inc., filed a 2011
- 3 annual report or paid 2012 regulatory fees?
- 4 A Yes, they have.
- 5 Q Please turn your attention to the document
- 6 that's marked MP-1.
- 7 A (Complies.)
- 8 Q Is this document a true and correct copy of
- 9 the 2011 annual report that A+ Always Moving, Inc.,
- 10 recently filed with the Commission?
- 11 A Yes.
- 12 Q When was that report filed?
- 13 A January 30th, 2013.
- Q Has A+ Always Moving, Inc., remitted its 2012
- 15 regulatory fee?
- 16 A Yes.
- 17 Q Please turn your attention to the document
- 18 marked Exhibit No. MP-2.
- 19 A (Complies.)
- 20 Q Is this document a true and correct copy of
- 21 the ARTS record for this carrier?
- 22 A Yes.
- Q When did A+ Always Moving, Inc., remit the
- 24 2012 regulatory fee?
- 25 A Also January 30th, 2013.

- 1 MS. CAMERON-RULKOWSKI: I offer Exhibits
- 2 MP-1 and MP-2 for admission into evidence.
- 3 JUDGE WATSON: They will be admitted.
- 4 Q What is your recommendation regarding this
- 5 company?
- 6 A I recommend that the company's permit not be
- 7 cancelled and that the Commission dismiss the
- 8 complaint against the company.
- 9 Q Was A A Star Transfer Co., Inc., one of the
- 10 companies referred to you by financial services?
- 11 A Yes.
- 12 Q Has A A Star Transfer Co., Inc., filed a 2011
- 13 annual report?
- 14 A Yes.
- 15 Q Please turn your attention to the exhibit
- 16 marked MP-3.
- 17 A (Complies.)
- 18 Q Is this document a true and correct copy of
- 19 the 2011 annual report that A A Star Transfer Co.,
- 20 Inc., recently filed with the Commission?
- 21 A Yes.
- Q When was that report filed?
- 23 A It was filed today, February 4th, 2013.
- Q Has A A Star Transfer Co., Inc., paid its 2012
- 25 regulatory fee?

- 1 A Yes, the company has paid \$153.49 of its
- 2 regulatory fee.
- 3 Q Please turn your attention to the document
- 4 marked Exhibit No. MP-4.
- 5 A (Complies.)
- 6 Q Is this document a true and correct copy of
- 7 the ARTS record for this carrier?
- 8 A Yes.
- 9 Q When did A A Star Transfer Co., Inc., remit
- 10 the 2012 regulatory fee?
- 11 A Today also, February 4, 2013.
- 12 Q Did A A Star Transfer Co., Inc., remit the
- penalty and delinquent fee required by RCW 81.80.321?
- 14 A No.
- 15 Q For the purposes of this proceeding, do you
- 16 consider that the company has come into full
- 17 compliance?
- 18 A No.
- 19 MS. CAMERON-RULKOWSKI: I offer Exhibits
- 20 MP-3 and MP-4 for admission into evidence.
- JUDGE WATSON: They will be admitted.
- 22 Since you brought the penalty in the A A Star
- 23 permit, I was going to wait until the end to ask you
- about this, but did A+ pay a penalty?
- MS. CAMERON-RULKOWSKI: Your Honor, I'm

- 1 referring only to the penalty, the 2 percent penalty,
- that is required under RCW 81.80.321 for late-filed
- 3 annual reports. When a company does then pay its --
- 4 sorry, for late-filed regulatory fees. When a company
- 5 does pay its regulatory fee, then they are required in
- 6 that statute to add a penalty, that is provided for
- 7 right in that statute, and then also a fee. That's
- 8 set forth in RCW 81.80.321.
- 9 JUDGE WATSON: And A A Star did not pay
- 10 that?
- 11 MS. CAMERON-RULKOWSKI: That's correct,
- 12 Your Honor. That is what Mr. Perkinson just
- 13 testified.
- JUDGE WATSON: Right, I just wanted to
- 15 clarify. I still don't understand about A+. Was A+
- 16 required to pay a similar penalty?
- MS. CAMERON-RULKOWSKI: Yes, your Honor,
- 18 it's automatic. They would have paid that amount. In
- 19 fact, it is calculated right on the regulatory fee
- 20 calculation sheet, which is the last page of the
- 21 annual report.
- JUDGE WATSON: So they paid it?
- MS. CAMERON-RULKOWSKI: That's correct,
- 24 Your Honor.
- 25 Mr. Perkinson, do you agree with my

- 1 representations?
- 2 MR. PERKINSON: Yes, A+ Always Moving
- 3 paid \$51.12.
- JUDGE WATSON: Okay, good. Thank you.
- 5 Q And, Mr. Perkinson, what is your
- 6 recommendation for A A Star Transfer Co., Inc.?
- 7 A I recommend that the company's permit not be
- 8 cancelled on the condition that the company pay the
- 9 statutory penalty and fee within ten days after the
- 10 order in this proceeding is issued.
- 11 Q Thank you.
- 12 Was Always Able Moving Service, LLC, one of
- 13 the companies referred to you by financial services?
- 14 A Yes.
- 15 Q Has Always Able Moving Services, LLC, filed a
- 16 2011 annual report or paid the 2012 regulatory fee?
- 17 A No.
- 18 Q What is your recommendation to the Commission
- 19 regarding this company?
- 20 A I recommend the Commission cancel the
- 21 company's permit.
- Q Was Arays Moving Service, LLC, one of the
- 23 companies referred to you by financial services?
- 24 A Yes, it was.
- Q Has Arays Moving Service, LLC, filed a 2011

- 1 annual report or paid 2012 regulatory fees?
- 2 A Yes.
- 3 Q Please turn your attention to the document
- 4 marked MP-5.
- 5 A (Complies.)
- 6 Q Is this document a true and correct copy of
- 7 the 2011 annual report that Arays Moving Service, LLC,
- 8 recently filed with the Commission?
- 9 A Yes.
- 10 Q When was this report filed?
- 11 A Today, February 4th, 2013.
- 12 Q Has Arays Moving Service, LLC, remitted its
- 13 2012 regulatory fee?
- 14 A Yes.
- 15 Q Please turn your attention to the exhibit
- 16 marked MP-6.
- 17 A (Complies.)
- 18 Q Is this document a true and correct copy of
- 19 the ARTS record for this carrier?
- 20 A Yes.
- 21 Q When did Arays Moving Service, LLC, remit the
- 22 2012 regulatory fee?
- 23 A Also today, February 4th, 2013.
- Q Looking at this ARTS record, it appears that
- 25 there still is an outstanding balance. Can you please

- 1 explain that?
- 2 A Yes, the company has submitted its payment
- 3 today. It is pending the credit card company
- 4 processing that payment.
- 5 Q For the purposes of this proceeding, do you
- 6 consider that the company has come into full
- 7 compliance?
- 8 A Yes, I do.
- 9 MS. CAMERON-RULKOWSKI: I offer Exhibits
- 10 MP-5 and MP-6 for admission into evidence.
- JUDGE WATSON: They will be admitted.
- 12 If you could just give me a second to take a note,
- 13 however, I would appreciate it.
- MS. CAMERON-RULKOWSKI: Certainly, Your
- 15 Honor.
- 16 (Pause in the proceedings.)
- JUDGE WATSON: Okay. Thank you.
- 18 MS. CAMERON-RULKOWSKI: Certainly, Your
- 19 Honor.
- 20 Q What is your recommendation for this company?
- 21 A I recommend that the company's permit not be
- 22 cancelled and the Commission dismiss the complaint
- 23 against the company.
- 24 Q Was Grayport Transfer & Storage one of the
- companies referred to you by financial services?

- 1 A Yes.
- 2 Q Has Grayport Transfer & Storage filed a 2011
- 3 annual report?
- 4 A Yes.
- 5 Q Please turn your attention to the document
- 6 marked Exhibit MP-7.
- 7 A (Complies.)
- 8 Q Is this document a true and correct copy of
- 9 the 2011 annual report that Grayport Transfer &
- 10 Storage recently filed with the Commission?
- 11 A Yes, it is.
- 12 Q When was that report filed?
- 13 A Today, February 4th, 2013.
- 14 Q Has Grayport Transfer & Storage paid its 2012
- 15 regulatory fee?
- 16 A It's like A A Star. The company has paid a
- portion, the \$156.82 portion of the penalty, and the
- 18 late payment and interest remaining on the account is
- 19 \$17.25.
- 20 Q Please turn your attention to the document
- 21 marked Exhibit No. MP-8.
- 22 A (Complies.)
- 23 Q Is this document a true and correct copy of
- the ARTS record for this carrier?
- 25 A Yes, it is.

- 1 Q And the regulatory fee amount, as well as the
- 2 penalty and the late fee amount that you just
- 3 testified about, is that represented here on this ARTS
- 4 record?
- 5 A Yes, it is. You can find those totals under
- 6 the charged amount column near the bottom of the page.
- 7 Q And when did Grayport Transfer & Storage pay
- 8 the regulatory fee portion of the amount that was due?
- 9 A Today.
- 10 Q For the purposes of this proceeding, do you
- 11 consider that the company has come into full
- 12 compliance?
- 13 A No.
- 14 MS. CAMERON-RULKOWSKI: I offer Exhibits
- 15 No. MP-7 and MP-8 for admission into evidence.
- JUDGE WATSON: They will be admitted.
- 17 Q What is your recommendation for this company?
- 18 A I recommend that the company's permit not be
- 19 cancelled on the condition that the company pay the
- 20 statutory penalty and fee within ten days after the
- 21 order in this proceeding issues.
- 22 Q Thank you.
- MS. CAMERON-RULKOWSKI: I have no
- 24 further questions for Mr. Perkinson.
- I do have a brief summary prepared, when you

- 1 are ready.
- JUDGE WATSON: I don't think I have any
- 3 questions. I think you covered it, subject to check.
- 4 (Pause in the proceedings.)

- 6 EXAMINATION
- 7 BY JUDGE WATSON:
- 8 Q So the question is, there's two types of
- 9 penalties. Were Grayport and A A Star assessed
- 10 penalties besides the 2 percent for failure to file
- 11 their report?
- 12 A Yes, both companies were assessed the \$2100
- 13 penalty.
- 14 Q They were. And did they pay?
- 15 A They have not paid those.
- 16 Q And where does that show up on ARTS?
- 17 A At the bottom of the page. If you are
- 18 looking -- are you looking for the annual report \$2100
- 19 penalty?
- Q Yes.
- 21 A That portion isn't displayed in the ARTS
- 22 database. It would show under the docket for wherever
- 23 that penalty assessment was issued.
- Q But you checked that docket to see whether or
- 25 not the 2100 had been paid?

- 1 A Yes, I checked right before this hearing.
- Q Well, the late interlopers -- so we talked
- 3 about Graystar and we talked about A A Star -- I'm
- 4 sorry, Grayport. And what about Arays?
- 5 A Arays did pay its penalty of \$2100 on
- 6 January 23rd, 2013.
- 7 Q So it paid the penalty before it filed the
- 8 annual report and paid the annual fee? Because you
- 9 said -- unless I got this wrong, because I thought you
- 10 said that the credit card company was still processing
- 11 their payment?
- 12 A That's correct. The company filed its annual
- 13 report and then it paid the regulatory fees today. It
- paid the penalty assessment of \$2100 on January 23rd.
- 15 Q Oh, okay. That's interesting.
- And A+, were they assessed and did they pay
- 17 \$2100?
- 18 A The company was assessed and it has not paid
- 19 the \$2100.
- 20 O That covers the late filers.
- 21 JUDGE WATSON: Did you have some closing
- 22 remarks?
- MS. CAMERON-RULKOWSKI: Yes, your Honor.
- 24 At this time I would like to summarize Staff's
- 25 recommendations.

- 1 Staff recommends that the Commission cancel
- 2 the permits of two of the household goods carriers
- 3 named in this proceeding, 3rd Generation Movers and
- 4 Hauling and Always Able Moving Service, LLC. Neither
- of these companies filed a 2011 annual report, nor
- 6 remitted regulatory fees for 2012.
- 7 A A Star Transfer Co., Inc., and Grayport
- 8 Transfer & Storage have filed their annual reports and
- 9 have paid regulatory fees but have not paid the
- 10 penalty and interest on late regulatory fees required
- 11 by RCW 81.80.321. For these companies Staff
- 12 recommends that the companies' permit not be cancelled
- on the condition that these companies pay the
- 14 statutory penalty and fee within ten days after the
- order in this proceeding issues.
- With regard to Thunder Movers, LLC, this
- 17 company has been dismissed from the proceeding by
- 18 yourself, earlier today.
- 19 The remaining respondent companies in this
- 20 proceeding have come into compliance, and Staff has
- 21 presented evidence that they filed the annual report
- 22 and paid all of the required fees. Staff therefore
- 23 moves to dismiss the Commission's complaint against A+
- 24 Always Moving, Inc., and Arays Moving Service, LLC.
- 25 That concludes Staff's presentation.
