Dear Mr. Johnson:

As you are aware, on April 24, 2013, the Washington Utilities and Transportation Commission issued Order 02, Initial Order and Default Order, assessing a financial penalty against you doing business as Jeff's Express Movers in the amount of \$5,000 for two violations of RCW 81.80.075(1), offering to transport household goods in the state of Washington and advertising to transport household goods without first obtaining the required permit from the Commission, and failing to appear at the hearing. Order 02 became final on May 15, 2013.

The Commission has not received the \$5,000 payment due and owing.

This is to notify you that the Commission intends to forward your outstanding debt to a collection agency for collection. You likely will incur additional expenses and fees, including costs of collection, attorney's fees, and interest. These expenses and fees will be added to your outstanding \$5,000 balance.
