Dear Urbn Attic LLC:

On November 18, 2015, Urbn Attic LLC filed an application with the Washington Utilities and Transportation Commission (Commission) to provide residential household goods transportation services in the state of Washington. On November 20, 2015, the Commission approved the application in part and granted Urbn Attic LLC temporary authority to provide those services.

The Commission has determined that Urbn Attic LLC qualifies for permanent household goods carrier authority and approves the application in full. Permit HG066184 issued in the name of Urbn Attic LLC is enclosed, and the company may now operate on a permanent basis.

Urbn Attic LLC must continue to comply with state laws, Commission rules, and the provisions of Tariff 15-C. Failure to do so will result in Commission enforcement action, up to and including revocation of the company's permit.
