TO ALL INTERESTED PERSONS:

The Washington Utilities and Transportation Commission (Commission) will accept comments on Pacific Power & Light Company's (Pacific Power or Company) integrated resource plan for electric service. An "integrated resource plan" (IRP or Plan) describes the mix of generation and supply resources and efficiency improvements that will meet both the current and future energy demands at the lowest reasonable cost to the utility and its ratepayers.

The Commission will review Pacific Power's integrated resource plan for electric service at an open public meeting. Pacific Power representatives will present the Plan to the Commission and respond to questions from the Commissioners and the public at a recessed open meeting of the Commission to be held on **Tuesday, July 11, 2017, at 9:30 a.m.** The meeting will be held at the Commission's headquarters, Room 139, Richard Hemstad Building, 1300 S. Evergreen Park Drive S.W., Olympia, Washington.

A copy of the IRP is on file in the library at the Commission's offices in Olympia, and on Pacific Power's website at <https://www.pacificpower.net/about/irp.html>. Requests for copies of the Plan should be directed to Pacific Power.

WRITTEN COMMENTS

Written comments must be filed with the Commission no later than **5:00 p.m. on June 16, 2017**. The Commission requests that comments be provided in electronic format to enhance public access, for ease of providing comments, to reduce the need for paper copies, and to facilitate quotations from the comments. Comments may be submitted via the Commission's Web portal at www.utc.wa.gov/e-filing or by electronic mail to the Commission's Records Center at records@utc.wa.gov. Please include:

- The docket number of this proceeding (UE-160353).
- The commenting party's name.
- The title and date of the comment or comments.

An alternative method for submitting comments may be by mailing or delivering an electronic copy to the Commission's Records Center on a 3 ½ inch, IBM-formatted, high-density disk, in .pdf Adobe Acrobat format or in Word 97 or later format, a flash drive, or CD. Include all of the information requested above. The Commission will post on its web site all comments that are provided in electronic format.
