NOTICE CANCELLING BRIEF ADJUDICATIVE PROCEEDING
(Set for March 6, 2018, at 2 p.m.)

In the Matter of the Certificate of Public and Convenience and Necessity of Speedishuttle of Washington, LLC d/b/a Speedishuttle Seattle, Docket No. TC-180161

TO ALL PARTIES:

On November 20, 2017, Speedishuttle Washington, LLC d/b/a Speedishuttle Seattle (Speedishuttle or Company) filed with the Washington Utilities and Transportation Commission (Commission) a petition in Docket TC-171144 requesting to temporarily discontinue its auto transportation service and seeking an exemption from the notice requirements in Washington Administrative Code (WAC) WAC 480-30-186 (Petition).

On February 23, 2018, the Commission issued a Notice of Hearing on Petition to Temporarily Discontinue Service; Notice of Intent to Cancel Certificate; Notice of Consolidation; Notice of Brief Adjudicative Proceeding, Setting Time for Oral Statements, set for Tuesday, March 6, 2018, at 2 p.m.

On March 1, 2018, Speedishuttle filed with the Commission a request to voluntarily cancel its certificate in Docket TC-180184. On March 2, 2018, the Commission entered Order 01 in that docket cancelling the Company's auto transportation certificate effective immediately.

Because the Company's voluntary cancellation of its auto transportation certificate eliminates the underlying dispute in both dockets, the Commission finds good cause to cancel the brief adjudicative proceeding.

THE COMMISSION GIVES NOTICE That the brief adjudicative proceeding set for March 6, 2018, at 2 p.m. is cancelled, and Dockets TC-171144 and TC-180161 are closed.
