RE: In the Matter of the Penalty Assessment Against Andrews Landshapers in the Amount of \$1,000, Docket D-190113

TO ALL PARTIES:

On April 16, 2019, the Washington Utilities and Transportation Commission (Commission) assessed a \$1,000 penalty (Penalty Assessment) against Andrews Landshapers (Company) for one violation of Revised Code of Washington (RCW) 19.122.030(2) for failing to obtain a valid dig ticket prior to performing an excavation. In the Penalty Assessment, the Commission offered the Company the option to suspend, and ultimately waive, \$800 of the penalty subject to the condition that (1) the Company pay the \$200 remaining portion of the penalty; (2) the Company owner attends Dig Safe training provided through the National Utility Contractors Association (NUCA) within 12 months of the date of the Penalty Assessment; and (3) the Company commit no further violations of RCW 19.122 within 12 months from the date of the Penalty Assessment.

On May 20, 2019, the Company paid the \$200 portion of the penalty that was not suspended and notified the Commission that it accepted the remaining conditions.

On April 16, 2020, Commission staff (Staff) filed a letter informing the Commission that the Company had met all of the conditions. In its letter, Staff recommended the Commission waive the \$800 suspended portion of the penalty and close the docket.

The Commission agrees that Andrews Landshapers has complied with the conditions of the penalty suspension. The \$800 suspended portion of the penalty is thus waived, and this docket is closed.
