Commission Staff Recommendation to Waive Suspended Penalties of Order 01
Docket TV-200271

Dear Ms. Maxwell:

On April 28, 2020, the Washington Utilities and Transportation Commission entered Order 01, Granting Mitigation, In Part; Imposing and Suspending Penalty in Docket TV-200271. Order 01 granted Joel Cisneros, d/b/a Always Movin' Moving Company's, (Always Movin' or Company) request for mitigation, reducing the assessed penalty of \$2,900 to \$1,500 and suspended a \$1,000 portion of the penalty for two years, and then waived, subject to the following conditions:

- (1) Commission staff (Staff) conduct a follow-up investigation within two years, or as soon thereafter as practicable;
- (2) Always Movin' must not incur any repeat violations of acute or critical regulations; and
- (3) The Company pay the \$500 portion of the penalty that is not suspended.

On July 21, 2020, Always Movin' paid the \$500 portion of the penalty that was not suspended.

On April 28, 2022, Staff completed the required follow-up investigation. The Company did not receive any repeat acute or critical violations.

Staff finds that Always Movin' satisfied the conditions of Order 01 and recommends that the \$1,000 suspended penalty be waived.
