Commission Staff Compliance Update for Order 01 and Recommendation

Dear Ms. Maxwell:

On October 9, 2020, the Washington Utilities and Transportation Commission entered Order 01, Granting Mitigation, in Docket TG-200756. Order 01 assessed a \$10,400 penalty against Peninsula Sanitation Services, Inc., (Peninsula Sanitation or Company) and suspended a \$5,200 portion of the penalty for two years, and then waived, subject to the following conditions:

- (1) Commission staff (Staff) conduct a follow-up focused review in two years from the date of Order 01:
- (2) Peninsula Sanitation must not incur any repeat violations of acute or critical regulations, and;
- (3) The Company pay the \$5,200 portion of the penalty that is not suspended.

On October 21, 2020, Peninsula Sanitation paid the \$5,200 portion of the penalty that was not suspended.

On November 9, 2022, Staff completed the required follow-up investigation. The Company did not receive any repeat violations of acute or critical regulations.

Staff finds that Peninsula Sanitation satisfied the conditions of Order 01 and recommends that the \$5,200 suspended penalty be waived.
