On November 15, 2021, Puget Sound Energy (PSE), filed with the Washington Utilities and
Transportation Commission (Commission) a draft 2022 Distributed Energy Resources (DER)
Request for Proposals (RFP) for approval by the Commission, as required by Order 05 under
Docket UE-200413 and as specified in WAC 480-107. The proposed RFP and related documents
are available on the Commission’s website at www.utc.wa.gov, as well as on PSE’s website at
www.pse.com/rfp.

2022 PSE DER RFP – Preliminary Public Participation Schedule

Per WAC 480-107-017(3), interested persons may submit written comments to the Commission
within 45 days after the utility files its draft RFP, and WAC 480-107-017(4) provides for a 75-
day period during which the Commission will decide whether to approve, approve with
conditions, or suspend the filed draft RFP. Guided by these requirements, a preliminary public
participation schedule is provided below, and may be revised as needed.

Please include the following details:

- The commenting party's name.
- The title and date of the comment or comments.

Comments should be in .pdf format (created using Adobe Acrobat or comparable software) or in Microsoft Word. The Commission will post on its website all comments it receives in electronic format.
