RE: In the Matter of the Penalty Assessment Against Allied Resource Group in the Amount of \$1,000, Docket D-220317

TO ALL PARTIES:

On May 26, 2022, the Washington Utilities and Transportation Commission (Commission) assessed a \$1,000 penalty (Penalty Assessment) against Allied Resource Group (Allied Resource or Company) for one violation of Revised Code of Washington (RCW) 19.122.030(1) for failing to determine the precise location of a marked water line. The Penalty Assessment provided the Company with the opportunity to suspend, and ultimately waive, an \$800 portion of the penalty subject to the conditions that: a) Allied Resource pay \$200 of the penalty amount, b) Allied Resource management and field crew responsible for excavation complete National Utility Contractors Association (NUCA) Dig Safe Training within 45 days of the Penalty Assessment, and c) Allied Resource not incur any additional violations of RCW 19.22 within 12 months of the Penalty Assessment.

On July 15, 2022, the Company paid \$200 towards the penalty and notified the Commission that it accepted the conditions offered by the Penalty Assessment.

On June 1, 2023, Commission staff (Staff) filed a letter in this docket informing the Commission that the Company had complied with all of the conditions and recommending that the Commission waive the suspended \$800 portion of the penalty and close the docket.

The Commission agrees that Allied Resource has complied with the conditions required by the Penalty Assessment. The penalty is thus waived, and this docket is closed.
