Dear Mr. Killip,

Consistent with RCW 80.28.380 and in compliance with the requirements outlined in Commission Order No. 01 in Docket No. UG-230898 approving Avista's 2024-2025 Biennial Conservation Plan (BCP) with conditions, Avista Corporation, dba Avista Utilities (Avista or the Company), respectfully submits its 2025 Natural Gas Annual Conservation Plan (ACP).

Avista's Natural Gas ACP is intended to be a continuous planning process used to adaptively manage the Company's natural gas Energy Efficiency portfolio. For the 2025 ACP, Avista has estimated conservation savings to be 704,656 therms from local efforts as well as 3,734 therms of regionally acquired savings through the Northwest Energy Efficiency Alliance (NEEA), combining for a total estimate of 708,390 therms. The Company has provided in its ACP the annual estimated savings and budgets for each of its natural gas Energy Efficiency programs. Please see Appendix C for the annual program summary outlining Avista's planned savings by sector.
