NOTICE OF ERRATA TO ORDER 01

RE: In the Matter of the Joint Application of Northwest Fiber Holdco, LLC, and BCE Holding Corporation for an Order Approving the Transfer of Control of Ziply Fiber Northwest, LLC to BCE Holding Corporation, Docket UT-240951

TO ALL PARTIES:

On January 30, 2025, the Washington Utilities and Transportation Commission (Commission) issued Order 01 Protective Order with "Highly Confidential Provisions" (Order 01). It came to the Commission's attention that the docket number in Appendices A, B, and C were incorrect. The corrected appendices are attached.

Additionally, paragraph 13 of Order 01 erroneously stated that unredacted versions of each page of Highly Confidential Information should be submitted on light blue paper. Highly Confidential Information should be submitted on light gray paper. Paragraph 13 is hereby corrected as follows:

Placing a "Highly Confidential" stamp on the first page of a document indicates only that one or more pages contains Highly Confidential Information and will not serve to protect the entire contents of a multi-page document. Each page that contains Highly Confidential Information must be marked separately to indicate where Highly Confidential Information is redacted. The unredacted versions of each page containing Highly Confidential Information and provided under seal also must be stamped "Highly Confidential" and submitted on shaded gray paper with references (*i.e.*, highlighting or other markings) to show where Highly Confidential Information is redacted in the original document.
