- NATURE OF PROCEEDING. This proceeding involves a petition filed by DIECA Communications, Inc., d/b/a Covad Communications Company (Covad) requesting arbitration of amendments to its interconnection agreement with Qwest Corporation (Qwest) pursuant to 47 U.S.C. § 252(b) of the Telecommunications Act of 1996, Public Law No. 104-104, 101 Stat. 56 (1996) (Act), and the Federal Communications Commission's Triennial Review Order.¹
- 2 **CONFERENCE.** The Washington Utilities and Transportation Commission (Commission) convened a prehearing conference in this docket at Olympia,

- APPEARANCES. Karen Shoresman Frame, Senior Counsel, Denver, Colorado, and David Rice, Miller Nash, LLP, Seattle, Washington, represent Covad. Adam L. Sherr, Seattle, Washington, Mary Rose Hughes, Perkins Coie, LLP, Washington, D.C., and Winslow Waxter, Denver Colorado, represent Qwest. Contact information provided at the conference for the parties' representatives is attached as Appendix A to this order.
- ISSUES. The parties are continuing negotiations on the issues presented in Covad's petition and Qwest's response. The parties plan to identify issues for arbitration in an issues matrix to be filed on August 23, 2004.
- PROCEDURAL SCHEDULE. The parties agreed upon, and the Commission adopts, the procedural schedule attached to this Order as Appendix B, which is incorporated into the body of this Order by this reference.
- NOTICE OF HEARING. The Commission convenes a hearing in this matter to address the issues raised by the parties in the petition and answer. The hearing will be held on Thursday, August 26 and Friday, August 27, 2004, beginning at 9:30 a.m. on August 26, 2004 in the Commission's Hearing Room, Second Floor, Chandler Plaza Building, 1300 S. Evergreen Park Drive S. W., Olympia, Washington.
- DOCUMENT PREPARATION AND FILING REQUIREMENTS. Parties must file with the Commission an original plus 2 copies of all pleadings, motions, briefs, and other prefiled materials. Paper copies of these materials are required to conform to the format and publication guidelines set forth in WAC 480-07-395 and 480-07-460, and must be three-hole punched with *oversized* holes to allow

easy handling. The Commission may require a party to refile any document that fails to conform to these standards.

- All filings must be mailed to the Commission Executive Secretary, Washington Utilities and Transportation Commission, P.O. Box 47250, 1300 S. Evergreen Park Drive, S.W. The Commission prefers that parties furnish electronic copies in .pdf (Adobe Acrobat) format, supplemented by a separate file in MS Word 6.0 (or later), or WordPerfect 5.1 (or later) format. Parties are required to organize and identify electronic files as specified in WAC 480-07-140(5).
- electronically with the Commission in this proceeding with the permission of the administrative law judge. Under WAC 480-07-145(6), electronic submission of documents provides a one-day extension of the paper-filing requirement. If, at any time during this proceeding, parties are authorized to submit documents with the Commission electronically under WAC 480-07-145(6), Parties must submit the document to records@wutc.wa.gov, and file an original, plus 2 copies, of the document with the Commission by the following business day.

NOTICE TO PARTIES: Any objection to the provisions of this Order must be filed within ten (10) days after the service date of this Order, pursuant to WAC 480-07-430 and WAC 480-07-810. Absent such objection, this Order will control further proceedings in this matter, subject to Commission review.
