I. BACKGROUND

- 1 On May 30, 2003, Qwest Corporation filed with the Commission a petition for competitive classification of its basic business exchange telecommunications services, private branch (PBX), Centrex, and basic business features in Washington. If the Commission were to grant Qwest's petition, Qwest would no longer be required to offer these services pursuant to tariff, but would instead be authorized to offer them under price lists and the rules applicable thereto.
- 2 Pursuant to RCW 80.36.330(5), on June 30, 2003, the Commission entered Order No. 06, Order Requiring Disclosure of Information by Competitive Local Exchange Carriers (CLECs). The Order required CLECs to provide responses to three questions, with subparts, by July 18, 2003, and/or verification of Qwest responses by July 25, 2003. Appendix A to this order sets forth the questions contained in Order No. 06.
- ³ The questions were intended to obtain information about the degree to which competitive carriers actually provide local exchange business services in the state of Washington.
- 4 Two parties to this proceeding challenged the Commission's rulings requiring provision of the information in response to these questions. As a result of the challenge, the Commission has determined that CLECs should also be required

to provide current price information for all services they provide and about which they responded pursuant to the June 30, 2003, order.

II. ORDER

- 5 THE COMMISSION ORDERS That all CLECs providing business service in the state of Washington file with the Commission current price lists for any service about which they responded pursuant to the Commission's June 30, 2003, Order Requiring Disclosure of Information. Responses must be filed by August 4, 2003. Please send all responses to Lisa Watson, Assistant Attorney General, PO Box 40128, Olympia, Washington 98504-0128. - 6 Responses to this order are deemed not confidential, as price lists filed with the Commission under RCW 80.36.320 are not considered confidential. Responses should include a certification, such as the attached declaration form, that all data provided are true and accurate.
- 7 Staff must distribute compiled copies of the responses to the parties to this proceeding on or before August 8, 2003.
