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Please provide an annual timeline of when various activities would occur each year if the Company's proposal is accepted, such as stakeholder meetings, annual filings made, the review period for annual filings, the steps involved in the annual review, and determination by the Commission.

Response:

If Puget Sound Energy, Inc.'s ("PSE") proposal is accepted, PSE will propose planned replacement jobs by mid-summer 2012. These jobs would be sent to interested stakeholders by August 1, 2012. In August, a meeting to review these jobs would be scheduled. Subsequent to this meeting, PSE would file tariff sheets that would go into effect on November 1, 2012, based on the replacement plans. The process for the following year will include a report on the past year activities and progress, as well as a true-up of costs, in addition to the next year's plan.
