QWEST PETITION FOR APPROVAL
OF PID/PAP 2008 PARTIAL
SETTLEMENT

I Qwest Corporation (“Qwest”), on behalf of itself, Eschelon Telecom of Washington, Inc. (“Eschelon”), Covad Communications Company (“Covad”), McLeodUSA Telecommunications Services, Inc. (“McLeodUSA”), Integra Telecom of Washington, Inc. (“Integra”), XO Communications Services, Inc. (“XO”), Time Warner Telecom of Washington, LLC (“TWTC”), and Commission Staff (“Staff”) (collectively, the “Stipulating Parties” and each individually, a “Party”), petitions the Commission to consider and approve the attached Partial Settlement Regarding Certain Performance Indicator Definitions and Qwest Performance Assurance Plan Provisions (“2008 Partial Settlement”). The Stipulating Parties respectfully recommend that the Commission approve the 2008 Partial Settlement, apply the agreed upon changes to the Performance Indicator Definitions (“the PID” or “PIDs”), the Qwest Performance Assurance Plan (“PAP”) and to interconnection agreements containing the PID and/or PAP without individual amendment.

2 In addition to the 2008 Partial Settlement, which has three exhibits attached, this filing includes a Narrative in Support of 2008 Partial Settlement, and a “Change Guide” to assist the Commission in its review of the changes to the PAP since the June 2007 filing.
