TO ALL INTERESTED PERSONS:

The Washington Utilities and Transportation Commission (Commission) will accept comments on Avista Corporation d/b/a Avista Utilities' (Avista or Company) integrated resource plan. Per WAC 480-90-238, an "integrated resource plan" (IRP) means a plan describing the mix of natural gas supply and conservation designated to meet current and future needs at the lowest reasonable cost to the utility and its ratepayers.

A copy of the IRP can be accessed via Avista's gas IRP docket, available online through the Commission's Record Center. Requests for copies of the IRP should be directed to Avista.

WRITTEN COMMENTS

Written comments on the IRP must be filed with the Commission no later than 5:00 p.m. on May 28, 2021. The Commission requests that comments be provided in electronic format to enhance public access, for ease of providing comments, to reduce the need for paper copies, and to facilitate quotations from the comments. Comments may be submitted via the Commission's Web portal at www.utc.wa.gov/e-filing or by electronic mail to the Commission's Records Center at records@utc.wa.gov. Please include:

- The docket number of this proceeding (UG-190724).
- The commenting party's name.
- The title and date of the comment or comments.

Comments should be in .pdf format (created using Adobe Acrobat or comparable software) or in Microsoft Word. The Commission will post on its website all comments it receives in electronic format. The website is located at www.utc.wa.gov. Documents are generally posted within 24 hours of receipt. ***Please refer to Docket UG-190724 to ensure that you are placed on the appropriate service list.***
