SETTLEMENT AGREEMENT

**I. OVERVIEW**

1 Staff of the Washington Utilities and Transportation Commission (Staff) and Ride  
the Ducks of Seattle, LLC (Company) (collectively, the parties) adopt the following  
settlement agreement (Agreement) to resolve all issues in Docket TE-151906.

**II. JURISDICTION**

2 The Commission has jurisdiction to approve and enforce this Agreement.

**III. EFFECTIVE DATE**

3 This Agreement is effective on the service date of a final Commission order  
approving this Agreement, or on the date that an initial order approving this Agreement  
becomes a final order pursuant to WAC 480-07-825(7).

**IV. TERMS OF AGREEMENT**

4 Admission of liability. For settlement purposes, the Company admits the violations  
alleged in the Commission's First Amended Complaint.

5 Monetary penalty. The Commission imposes a penalty of \$222,000 (full penalty).  
The Company will pay \$110,400 of the full penalty (non-suspended penalty) pursuant to the  
terms of the payment plan set forth in Paragraph 6. The Commission suspends \$111,600 of

7           Public interest. The parties agree that this Agreement promotes the public interest,  
and that it is appropriate for unconditional Commission acceptance under WAC 480-07-750.

8           Advocacy. The parties agree to advocate for acceptance of this Agreement before the  
Commission. After the Commission accepts this Agreement, no party or its agents,  
employees, consultants, or attorneys will engage in advocacy contrary to the Agreement.

9           Other proceedings. This Agreement is for settlement purposes only and shall have no  
precedential or preclusive effect in other proceedings.

10          Final agreement. This Agreement supersedes all prior oral and written agreements  
concerning issues addressed herein.


11          Counterparts. The parties may execute this Agreement in counterparts.

she has authority to bind the party that he or she represents.


