TO ALL PARTIES:

On July 29, 2013, the CenturyLink Companies – Qwest Corporation; CenturyTel of Washington; CenturyTel of Inter Island; CenturyTel of Cowiche; and United Telephone Company of the Northwest (Collectively referred to as CenturyLink) filed with the Washington Utilities and Transportation Commission (Commission) a Motion to Dismiss Sprint as an Intervenor (Motion) in the above-referenced proceeding.

On July 31, 2013, Sprint Nextel Corporation (Sprint) filed with the Commission a Motion to Compel Full Responses to Data Requests (Motion) in this proceeding. The Commission has determined that it will conduct a hearing to resolve the Motions of CenturyLink and Sprint.
