POSITION OF COMMISSION STAFF ON PROPOSED SETTLEMENT OF DISPUTED ISSUES

#### INTRODUCTION

On August 27, 2004, Qwest Corporation, MCI, Inc., Eschelon Telecom of Washington, Inc., and Covad Communications Company, (collectively, the "Stipulating Parties") filed for the Commission's consideration a proposed Settlement of Disputed Issues ("Settlement Agreement") purportedly resolving "all outstanding issues in this Second Six-Month Review proceeding." (Settlement Agreement, at 1.)

The Staff of the Washington Utilities and Transportation Commission

("WUTC" or "Commission") has reviewed the proposed Settlement Agreement and
opposes the Settlement Agreement insofar as it proposes to eliminate PO-20 Tier 2

payments. In all other respects, Staff supports the Settlement Agreement and
requests the Commission act expeditiously to approve the Settlement Agreement
thereby ensuring that implementation deadlines set forth in the Settlement
Agreement may be met.

#### DISCUSSION

The parties to the Settlement Agreement acknowledge that the "WUTC Staff has not joined the Stipulation and has filed testimony that is in material disagreement with at least one proposed disposition in the Stipulation." *Id.* While proposing to eliminate PO-20 Tier 2 payments, the Stipulating Parties, at the same time, agree "to abide by the remainder of the Settlement" should Staff pursue the issue of Tier 2 payments independent of the Settlement Agreement. (Settlement Agreement, at 4 n.3.)

Given that a prehearing conference in this matter is scheduled for September 8, 2004, Staff requests that that the procedural question as to how the issue of PO-20 Tier 2 payments will be addressed be taken up at that time. Finally, Staff suggests that the appropriate Tier 2 designation for PO-20 be considered at the September 22, 2004, hearing at which the Commission will consider the Settlement Agreement.
