RE: Wash. Utils. & Transp. Comm'n v Avista Corp. d/b/a Avista Utils. Dockets UE-190334, UG-190335, and UE-190222

TO ALL PARTIES:

On March 25, 2020, the Washington Utilities and Transportation Commission (Commission) entered its final order, Order 09, Rejecting Tariff Sheets; Approving and Adopting Partial Multiparty Settlement Stipulation; Resolving Contested Issues; and Authorizing and Requiring Compliance Filing (Order 09) in Dockets UE-190334, UG-190335, and UE-190222 (*Consolidated*). Order 09, among other things, required Avista Corporation, d/b/a Avista Utilities (Avista or Company) to file tariff sheets in compliance with Order 09.

On March 26, 2020, the Company filed revised tariff sheets with a stated effective date of April 1, 2020.

On March 30, 2020, the Company filed supplemental revised tariff sheets with a stated effective date of April 1, 2020.

On March 31, 2020, Commission staff filed a letter in this docket stating that Staff had reviewed the revised tariff sheets and believes that the filing complies with the terms of Order 09 and the Partial Multiparty Settlement Stipulation approved therein.

The Commission finds that the revised tariff sheets filed on March 26, 2020, and supplemented on March 30, 2020, by Avista comply with Order 09. The Commission approves the revised tariff sheets, which will become effective on April 1, 2020.
