BACKGROUND

- 1 On April 15, 2004, Rabanco, LTD, d/b/a Sea-Tac Disposal (Sea-Tac or the Company) filed with the Commission revisions to its currently effective Tariff No. 25 to become effective June 1, 2004. The Company subsequently extended the effective date to July 1, 2004.
- 2 On June 30, 2004, the Commission entered a Complaint and Order Suspending Tariff Revisions pending an investigation to determine whether the revisions were fair, just and reasonable.
- 3 Commission Staff completed its review of Sea-Tac’s filing and justification documents in this docket and proposed an alternative set of revised rates, generally lower than those originally proposed to become effective by the company. Sea-Tac accepted the Staff findings and proposed rates and filed new revised tariff pages on July 23, 2004, reflecting that agreement.

FINDINGS AND CONCLUSIONS

- 4 (1) The Washington Utilities and Transportation Commission is an agency of the State of Washington vested by statute with the authority to regulate rates, rules, regulations, practices, accounts, securities, and transfers of public service companies, including solid waste companies. *RCW 80.01.040; Chapter 81.01 RCW; Chapter 81.04 RCW; Chapter 81.28 RCW and Chapter 81.77 RCW.*
- 5 (2) Rabanco LTD, d/b/a Sea-Tac is a solid waste company and is a public service company subject to the jurisdiction of the Commission.
- 6 (3) This matter was brought before the Commission at its regularly scheduled meeting on July 28, 2004.
- 7 (4) The new tariff revisions received on July 23, 2004, are in agreement with Staff recommendations in this docket and are fair, just and reasonable.
- 8 (5) After review of the tariff revision(s) filed in Docket TG-040697 by Rabanco LTD, d/b/a Sea-Tac Disposal, and giving due consideration, the Commission finds it is consistent with the public interest that the Complaint and Order Suspending Tariff Revision(s) in Docket TG-040697, dated June 30, 2004, be dismissed and the new tariff revisions received on July 23, 2004, to Tariff 25 become effective on August 1, 2004.

ORDER

THE COMMISSION ORDERS:

- 9 (1) The Complaint and Order Suspending Tariff Revision(s) in Docket TG-040697, dated June 30, 2004, is dismissed.

10 (2) The new tariff revisions filed in this docket on July 23, 2004, shall become effective on August 1, 2004.

11 The Commissioners, having determined this Order to be consistent with the public interest, directed the Secretary to enter this Order.
