Dear Mr. Webb:

On June 30, 2006, the Washington Utilities and Transportation Commission (the Commission) issued a Notice of Penalties to Palouse River & Coulee City Railroad (Palouse) in the amount of \$100 for violation of Washington Administrative Code (WAC) 480-62-300. WAC 480-62-300 requires railroad companies to furnish annual reports and pay regulatory fees to the commission no later than May 1 each year. The penalty assessment required Palouse to either pay the penalty or ask for mitigation within 15 days. Your company did neither.

This letter serves as a final chance for you to respond. If you do not respond by January 17, 2007, you may incur additional penalties and the Commission may pursue its enforcement options in superior court.
