plan. In fact many of the major generators have either indicated that they agree with extending the existing agreement or that they have no opinion one way or another. See, the signature pages attached as Exhibit 2. A strong, two-thirds majority of the generators agree that the existing agreement should be extended. Generators representing approximately thirteen percent of total revenues had no opinion. This means that approximately eighty percent of the generators either agree with or do not oppose extension of the existing agreement. Not a single generator expressed opposition to the extension.

4. Based on the foregoing, US Ecology respectfully requests that the attached Settlement Agreement (Exhibit 3) approved in Docket No. TL-070848 be extended to terminate on December 31, 2019, but in all other respects remain in full force and effect.

CONCLUSION

5. Based on the foregoing, US Ecology respectfully requests that the Commission approve this Petition.
