REVISED PROJECT AGREEMENT GRADE CROSSING PROTECTIVE FUND

A. PARTIES OF THE AGREEMENT

This revised project grant agreement (agreement) is entered into between the Washington Utilities and Transportation Commission (UTC), P.O. Box 47250, Olympia, Washington 98504-7250 and the City of Yakima, 129 North Second Street, Yakima, Washington, 98901, and shall be binding upon the agents and all persons acting by or through the parties.

B. PURPOSE OF THE REVISED AGREEMENT

This revised agreement sets out the terms and conditions by which grants are made from the Grade Crossing Protective Fund. These grants are administered by the UTC to the grantee for Docket No. TR-072009, identified above.

C. DESCRIPTION OF PROJECT

TR-072009 involves installing fencing designed to prevent pedestrian trespass onto the BNSF and trolley bridges and approaches to the bridges. The fencing will be installed along the Naches River at the City of Yakima's northern city limits in Yakima County, Washington.

D. PERIOD OF PERFORMANCE

The project reimbursement period shall begin on April 30, 2008, and end June 30, 2009. No expenditure made before or after this period is eligible for reimbursement unless incorporated by written amendment into this agreement.

E. PROJECT FUNDING

Total grant funding awarded by the UTC for this project shall not exceed \$20,000. The total approximate cost of the project is \$35,000. The grantee shall be responsible for all costs over \$20,000.

F. RIGHTS AND OBLIGATIONS

All rights and obligations of the parties to this revised agreement are subject to this agreement and its attachments, including the grantee's application, commission orders, and the general provisions, all of which are attached and incorporated into this agreement.

Except as provided, no alteration of any of the terms or conditions of this revised agreement will be effective unless provided in writing. All alterations must be signed by both parties.

The grantee has read, fully understands and agrees to be bound by all terms and conditions in these documents.

G. COMPLIANCE WITH APPLICABLE STATUTES, RULES, AND UTC POLICIES
This revised agreement is governed by, and the grantee shall comply with, all
applicable state and federal laws and regulations, including RCW 81.53.281, the
published agency rules in 480-62 WAC, and the commission's order in this matter
which are incorporated by this reference as if fully set forth.
