Recommendation

1. Continue the Complaint and Order Suspending the Tariff Revisions filed by Fircroft, Inc.; and

2. Allow temporary rates at the Staff recommended revised rates to become effective September 15, 2008, on less than statutory notice, subject to refund.

Discussion

On July 7, 2008, Fircroft, Inc., (Fircroft or company), filed with the Utilities and Transportation Commission (Commission) tariff revisions that would generate \$4,788 (21 percent) in additional revenue per year. The company serves 14 residential customers and two master meter customers, serving a total of 52 customers, near East Sound on Orcas Island, located in San Juan County. The proposed rates are prompted by cost increases in supplies, electrical power, labor, and increased maintenance and repairs for aging plant. All customers receive metered service. The company's last general rate increase became effective in 2000, prior to becoming regulated.

On July 3, 2008, the company notified its customers of the rate increase by mail. The Commission received two customer comments on this filing prior to the August 14, 2008, open meeting. Staff's memorandum, dated August 14, 2008, summarized and responded to those customers' comments.

The Commission found that the company had not demonstrated that the proposed rates were fair, just, reasonable and sufficient, and suspended this filing at its August 14, 2008, open meeting.

Staff completed its review and the company agreed to a lower revenue requirement of \$2,400 (8 percent) additional revenue per year. On August 29, 2008, the company filed a revised rate design at the Staff recommended level. The company's original customer notice of July 3, 2008, did not contain the revised rate design and, as a result, the company is petitioning the Commission for an exemption from WAC 480-110-425 to allow the new rate design to go into effect with the revised rates at Staff recommended levels on less than statutory notice.

To allow customers the opportunity to comment on the revised rate design before determining whether the revised rates are fair, just, reasonable, and sufficient, the Commission should continue the Complaint and Order Suspending Tariff Revisions and allow the revised rates to go into effect on September 15, 2008, on a temporary basis, subject to refund.

On August 15, 2008, Commission Staff sent every customer who commented on the filing a letter advising then of Staff's recommended action. The Commission has received two additional customer comments and Staff's responses are summarized in the attachment.
