- NATURE OF PROCEEDING. This proceeding arises out of a Complaint filed on May 1, 2013, by the Washington Utilities and Transportation Commission (Commission) against Shuttle Express, Inc. (Shuttle Express or Company).
- The Complaint alleges that between October 2010 and September 2011, Shuttle Express operated an independent contractor program to transport passengers on occasions when the Company's own drivers and equipment were not readily available to ensure customers would not miss scheduled flights out of Seattle-Tacoma International Airport. The Complaint alleges that the Company violated WAC 480-30-213(2), WAC 480-30-216(6), WAC 480-30-456, and Order 01 entered in Docket TC-072228 on July 11, 2008.
- On May 24, 2013, Shuttle Express filed an answer denying all allegations.
- 4 **CONFERENCE.** The Commission convened a prehearing conference in this docket at Olympia, Washington, on Tuesday, June 18, 2013, before Administrative Law Judge Adam E. Torem, whom the Commission appoints as presiding officer in this matter.
- 5 **APPEARANCES.** Jennifer Cameron-Rulkowski, Assistant Attorney General, Olympia, WA, represents the Commission's regulatory staff (Commission Staff or

Staff). Imy Sherrell, Renton, WA, represents Shuttle Express. Contact information for the parties' representatives is attached as Appendix A to this order.

- 6 **INTERVENTION**. The Commission did not receive any requests for intervention.
- **DISCOVERY.** The parties agreed that formal discovery is not anticipated to be necessary in this matter.
- 8 **PROCEDURAL SCHEDULE.** The parties agreed on, and the Commission adopts, the following procedural schedule:

- NOTICE OF HEARING. The Commission will hold an evidentiary hearing in this matter commencing on Thursday, August 1, 2013, at 9:30 a.m., in Room 108, First Floor, Richard Hemstad Building, 1300 S. Evergreen Park Drive S.W., Olympia, Washington.
- DOCUMENT PREPARATION AND FILING REQUIREMENTS. Parties must file an **original plus 5 copies** of all pleadings, motions, briefs, and other prefiled materials. These materials must conform to the format and publication guidelines in WAC 480-07-395 and WAC 480-07-460. The Commission prefers that materials be three-hole punched with *oversized* holes to allow easy handling. The Commission may require a party to refile any document that fails to conform to these standards.
- All filings must be mailed or delivered to the Executive Director and Secretary, Washington Utilities and Transportation Commission, P.O. Box 47250, 1300 S.

NOTICE TO PARTIES: A party who objects to any portion of this Order must file a written objection within ten (10) calendar days after the service date of this Order, pursuant to WAC 480-07-430 and WAC 480-07-810. The service date appears on the first page of the order in the upper right-hand corner. Absent such objection, this Order will control further proceedings in this matter, subject to Commission review.
