**RE: Notice of Intent to Send to Collections, Penalty Assessment No. TV-120900**

Dear Sir or Madam:

As you are aware, on July 23, 2012, the Washington Utilities and Transportation Commission issued a Penalty Assessment against 3<sup>rd</sup> Generation Movers and Hauling in the amount of \$2,100 for violation of WAC 480-15-480, which requires household goods carriers to file an annual report with the Commission by May 1 each year. 3<sup>rd</sup> Generation Movers and Hauling failed to file its annual report for 2011 and incurred a penalty of \$2,100. On February 4, 2014, the Commission entered Order 01, Order Granting Request for Payment Arrangement. The Order provides that if 3<sup>rd</sup> Generation fails to timely pay one installment, the entirety of the remaining balance of the assessed penalty will become immediately due and payable. The Commission's records reflect that 3<sup>rd</sup> Generation did not make the installment payment due on February 18, 2014, and under the terms of Order 01, the entire penalty of \$2,100 is now due and payable. The Commission sent 3<sup>rd</sup> Generation Movers and Hauling a Final Notice on March 19, 2014.

The Commission has not received the \$2,100 payment due and owing.

**This is to notify you that the Commission intends to forward your outstanding debt to a collection agency for collection.** You likely will incur additional expenses and fees, including costs of collection, attorney's fees, and interest. These expenses and fees will be added to your outstanding \$2,100 balance.
