RE: Notice of Intent to Send to Collections, Penalty Assessment No. TV-120900

Dear Sir or Madam:

As you are aware, on July 23, 2012, the Washington Utilities and Transportation Commission issued a Penalty Assessment against 3rd Generation Movers and Hauling in the amount of \$2,100 for violation of WAC 480-15-480, which requires household goods carriers to file an annual report with the Commission by May 1 each year. 3rd Generation Movers and Hauling failed to file its annual report for 2011 and incurred a penalty of \$2,100. On February 4, 2014, the Commission entered Order 01, Order Granting Request for Payment Arrangement. The Order provides that if 3rd Generation fails to timely pay one installment, the entirety of the remaining balance of the assessed penalty will become immediately due and payable. The Commission's records reflect that 3rd Generation did not make the installment payment due on February 18, 2014, and under the terms of Order 01, the entire penalty of \$2,100 is now due and payable. The Commission sent 3rd Generation Movers and Hauling a Final Notice on March 19, 2014.

The Commission has not received the \$2,100 payment due and owing.

This is to notify you that the Commission intends to forward your outstanding debt to a collection agency for collection. You likely will incur additional expenses and fees, including costs of collection, attorney's fees, and interest. These expenses and fees will be added to your outstanding \$2,100 balance.
