Commission Staff's recommendation to impose suspended penalty.

Dear Mr. Johnson,

On May 7, 2018, Tomas Castellon, d/b/a Bulldog Concrete Services, LLC (Bulldog Concrete) was issued a \$1,000 penalty for a violation of RCW 19.122.030(2). Bulldog Concrete was provided the opportunity to have the \$800 of the penalty amount suspended and ultimately waived on the following conditions:

- Bulldog Concrete employees attend Dig Safe training provided through the National Utility Contractors Association (NUCA) within six months of the date of the penalty assessment; and
- Submit documentation of attendance of Dig Safe training within 5 days of attendance; and
- Commit no further violations of RCW 19.122 within the 12 months following the penalty assessment.

On June 22, 2018, Bulldog Concrete made a \$200 payment, and responded in writing that they would accept the Commission's conditions to suspend \$800 of the penalty.

The Commission's Pipeline Safety Program has not received the required documentation of attendance of training, and NUCA has no record of Bulldog Concrete employees attending Dig Safe training. Therefore, staff recommends the suspended \$800 penalty be imposed on Bulldog Concrete for failing to meet the condition of attending Dig Safe training within six months of the issuance of the penalty assessment.
