4 **Q. Please state your name, business address, and position with Puget Sound**  
5 **Energy.**

6 A. My name is Kimberly J. Harris. My business address is 10885 NE Fourth Street,  
7 P.O. Box 97034, Bellevue, WA 98009-9734. I am the President and Chief  
8 Executive Officer of Puget Sound Energy (“PSE”).

9 **Q. By whom are you employed and in what capacity?**

10 A. I am PSE’s President and Chief Executive Officer (“CEO”).

11 **Q. What are your duties as President and Chief Executive Officer?**

12 A. I have overall management responsibility for PSE. In consultation with our  
13 executive team and Board of Directors, I set PSE’s strategic business goals and  
14 direct our efforts to achieve these goals. I also serve on the board of PSE, Puget  
15 Energy, Inc., and Puget Holdings LLC.

16 **Q. Briefly describe your education and relevant employment experience.**

17 A. I graduated from San Diego State University in December of 1986 with a  
18 Bachelor of Arts degree in Political Science. I graduated from Arizona State  
19 University in 1989 with a Juris Doctorate degree.

I worked as an attorney for the law firm Wagstaff, Alvis, Stubbeman, Seamster & Longacre, L.L.P., in Abilene, Texas, from 1990 until 1994. From 1994 until 1999, I was an attorney for the law firm Perkins Coie LLP in Bellevue, Washington.

I joined PSE in 1999 as an Associate General Counsel. I also served as PSE's Director of Load Resource Strategies. In February of 2003, I became Vice President of Regulatory and Government Affairs, in which position I was responsible for PSE's regulatory strategy at this Commission and at the Federal Energy Regulatory Commission, and for governmental affairs at the federal level. Prior to serving as President and CEO, I served as Executive Vice President and Chief Resource Officer. I was named President of PSE in June 2010 and CEO in March 2011.

I serve as the 2018 chair of the American Gas Association. I served as the 2017 chair of the Washington Roundtable and 2016-2017 campaign chair for the United Way of King County. In October 2014, I joined the U.S. Bancorp Board of Directors.
