NOTICE ACKNOWLEDGING TARIFF FILING WITHDRAWAL

RE: *Washington Utilities and Transportation Commission v. Cascade Natural Gas Corporation, Docket UG-190775*

TO ALL PARTIES:

On September 13, 2019, Cascade Natural Gas Corporation (Cascade or Company) filed with the Washington Utilities and Transportation Commission (Commission) revisions to its tariff Schedule 583, Temporary Federal Income Tax Rate Credit, (Tariff Filing) for rates effective November 1, 2019.

On October 24, 2019, the Commission heard this matter at its regularly scheduled open meeting, and later that day entered Order 01, Complaint and Order Suspending Tariff Revisions (Order 01). Order 01 concluded that the proposed tariff revisions warrant further investigation and provided notice that the Commission may hold hearings at such times and places as may be required to adjudicate any contested issues.

On December 18, 2019, Cascade filed with the Commission a Notice of Withdrawal of Tariff Filing (Notice of Withdrawal). In the Notice of Withdrawal, Cascade states that the Tariff Filing was intended to true up the Tax Cuts and Jobs Act benefit amount that Cascade over-refunded to customers in compliance with Order 06, Final Order Rejecting Tariff Sheets (Order 06) in UG-170929. Cascade further states that following the open meeting and Order 01, Cascade consulted with Commission staff regarding a different approach to recovering the over-refunded amount and now intends to include it in the annual true-up of Schedule 582, which will be filed in mid-September 2020. Cascade requests the Commission acknowledge its Notice of Withdrawal and close this docket.

THE COMMISSION GIVES NOTICE That the September 13, 2019, revisions to tariff Schedule 583, Temporary Federal Income Tax Rate Credit have been withdrawn and this docket is now closed.
