Attached please find original pages for Tariff Number 10, for Harold LeMay Enterprises, Inc., dba City Sanitary, Joe's Refuse, White Pass Garbage G-98.

With this filing, we respectfully request the Commission approve a general rate increase to recover new capital, higher costs of employee wages, benefits, and general operating costs.

The increase for Lewis County is proposed as follows: Residential service \$187,500, 7.7%; commercial service \$167,000, 7.7%; roll-off service \$48,500, 7.7%; residential/multi-family recycling service \$342,000, 47.9%; and yard waste service \$34,000, 97.7%. There are approximately 12,000 residential; 1,700 commercial; 80 roll-off; 11,000 residential recycling; 7 multi-family recycling; and 400 yard waste customers affected by this change.

For customers receiving service in Thurston County below 142<sup>nd</sup> Ave the proposed change is as follows: Residential service (\$39,000) (4.2%); commercial service (\$27,000) (4.2%); roll-off service (\$11,000) (4.2%); residential/multifamily recycling service (\$19,500) (5.3%); and yard waste service \$2,000, 16.3%. There are approximately 4,000 residential; 500 commercial; 15 roll-off; 4,000 residential recycling; 300 multi-family recycling; and 100 yard waste customers affected by this change.

The last general rate increase approved by The Commission for City Sanitary, Joe's Refuse, White Pass Garbage became effective November 1, 2010.

Attached are the proposed tariff pages containing the increased rates, as well as supporting documentation for those changes. If these rates are approved by the Washington Utilities and Transportation Commission they are intended to become effective on September 1, 2020.

Please note the Peirce County Ashford/Elbe service area has been removed from this tariff in this filing. This service territory was moved to Harold LeMay Enterprises, Inc. dba Pierce County Refuse, effective May 1, 2020 in TG-190516.

Included in this filing is our non-regulated operation, as our regulated and non-regulated operations share one facility. To protect certain non-regulated proprietary information we are filing a portion of this filing as confidential, and are filing in accordance with WAC 480-07-160.

A rate increase notification letter will be mailed to all customers affected by these proposed changes no later than July 31, 2020. A notice letter will also be delivered on or before July 31, 2020 to the office of the Lewis County and Thurston County Council Chairs.
