TO ALL PARTIES:

On December 28, 2021, the Washington Utilities and Transportation Commission (Commission) entered Order 02, Classifying Respondent as a Charter Party or Excursion Service Carrier; Ordering Respondent to Cease and Desist; Suspending and Waiving Penalties Subject to Condition (Order 02) against Nicholas Papadimas d/b/a Orion NW, (Orion NW or Company). Order 02 assessed a penalty of \$1,000 against Orion NW, the entirety of which was suspended, to be waived subject to the condition that Orion NW modify, take down, make inaccessible, or otherwise remove from its website all advertisements of charter party or excursion service within the state of Washington.

On February 17, 2022, Commission staff (Staff) filed a letter in this docket informing the Commission that the Staff had reviewed the Company's website and found no references to charter party or excursion services. In its letter, Staff states that it believes that Orion NW has satisfied the condition of Order 02 and recommends that the Commission waive the suspended penalty and close the docket.

The Commission finds that Orion NW has complied with the conditions of Order 02. The \$1,000 penalty is now waived, and this docket is closed.
