RATE INCREASE NOTICE FOR ROLL OFF & COMPACTOR GARBAGE

Dear Customer:

February 25, 2022

Island Disposal Company, Inc. has filed a request for a rate increase with the Washington Utilities and Transportation Commission (WUTC). The last general rate increase was approved by the WUTC June 1, 2020. Since that time, the Company has experienced higher costs for employee wages, benefits, fuel, truck equipment and has purchased additional capital assets.

If approved by the WUTC, the proposed rates below will become effective April 1, 2022.
